With reference to the complaint in respect of Tmt. Saroja, W/O Manickam, residing at Door No 693/XI, Malaikodi, Viswanathan Nagar, Ariyur, Vellore Taluk, Vellore District received together with the Notice referred to above, I have to state that matter has been to quired into by the Dy. Supdt. of Police, Vellore Sub-Division, Vellore in this enquiry report is furnished below

2. The alleged victim Tmt Saroja, belongs to Mudaliar caste. het husband Manickam belongs to Irular caste. She is a criminal involved in a theft case in Bagayam P.S.Cr.No. 193/2008 U/s 379 IPC gistered on the complaint of one Sonia Gandhi, W/o Srinivasan, ling at Katta Subedar Street, Kosapet, Vellore that while she was ling in Palamathi bus alongwith her husband and mother, the said a committed theft of gold jewels kept in her hand bag was caught and handed over to Bagayam Police on 07.05.2008 at 4.30 imilarly, the said Saroja joined with Rekha committed theft of

Cash Rs.18,000/- and Kancheepuram Silk Sarees which was registered Vellore South RS (\* No. 231/1987/1/5 381 IPC - both A1 & AV was suitenced for R1. Ion three months by the Court in CC 1877/198/- She was also arrested for an offence of illicit liquor case in Bagayam PS (\* No. 353/98 u/s 4(1)(i), -4(1-A) TNP Act and she was sentenced for three weeks R.I. and fine of Rs.300/- in CC No. 465/99.

3. That on 09.03.08 her husband Manickam, residing at Viswanathan Nagars Arivur—preferred a complaint that one A.G.Arumugam husband of Panchayat President and the Gudiyattame Assembly Member 1800 sentence Comments Party objecting the South of Party at to those missing residents was received and assigned CSR 69/08, conjuired into the same. On the statement of Counter Party A.C. Arumugam that he welld not interfere into the issue of party at the missing residents in the action was dropped.

That on 66.04.08, one Gnanti@Arumugam, had ward-member of the Panchayat presented a complaint that the said vetungamia way laid scolded him in filthy words was entertained, assigned USE No.99/08, investigated into by the Sub-Inspr. of Police, Bagayam p.s., had registered a case in Cr.No. 145/08 U/s 341, 294(b) iPC against the said victim Saroja after ascertaining the facts. This case was charge sheeted and pending before the Court. Aggrieved with the cases registered against her, she suppressed all the above facts and to exhibit herself as a normal lady, blaming the Bagayam Police that she was artured and ill treated with her caste name and intimidated only inview diverting the attention of Police from watching her illegal activities.

4. Apart from the above facts, there was dispute over the non assue of para to lew of the residents of Viswanathan Pagar, Ansyling the connection, her husband Manickam preferred a complaint and it was assigned CSR 199/08 and investigated into by the Sub-Inspr. of Police and found that the complaint was true the had registered a case in Cr 110. 264/08 U/s 107 Cr.P.C. and the case is under investigation of the Remove Divisional Officer, Vellore. As such, the Police Officers and men have discharged their legitimate duties impartially. Moreover, there is 110 specific reasons or enmity put forth to subject the victim to storture by the Police.

5 The averments made in the petition against the Police are bass less and fabricated in order to get monetary relief. Therefore, it is requested that in the Police are complaint may be dropped.
