Sub: Police - Nellore Dist. - Andhra Pradesh-Alleged atrocity on a member of S.T., by name Sri Dasari Nagabhusanam, Duttalur village - Enquiry report - Forwarding of - Regarding.

Ref:-AP/ST-9/2006-Atrocity, dated: 15.5.2006 of the National Commission for STs., New Delhi.

Adverting to the reference cited, I am to state that the contents of the representation made by sri Dasari Magablusanam of B.C., colony, Buttalur viilage, Nellore district were got enquired into and it relates to Cr.No. 18/2006 u/s 323 IPC, 3(1)(x) SCs/STs(POA) Act, 1989 of Buttalur Folice Station. Following are the facts elecited during the investigation.

On 14.4.2006 at 1600 hours, the complainant Sri Desard Negabhusanam, S.T., Auto driver, B.C.Coleny, Duttallur ledged a report in Duttalur Police Station stating that the accused Nabasha and Johny (Vartha reporter) while playing cricket with their friends, near his house, the cricket ball fell into his house twice and also into a the back of his wife. When the petitioner asked them about it, an alteration took place between them. Later, the accused Johny abused bim affending his caste and both the accused beat him and accused

bleeding injury at below the eye.

The said report was registered as a case in Cr. No. 18/2006 u/s 323 IPC, 3(1)(x)SCs/STs(FOA)Act, 1989 of Duttalur Police Station and the case was investigated into by the Sub-Divisional Police Officer, Kavali.

During the course of investigation, as many as 8 witnesses were examined by the investigating officer and the investigation disclosed as follows.

The accused Johnny Basha(A1) and Shaik Kahaboob Basha(A2) and some others of the B.C. colony, Buttalur village used to play cricket at the playground situated near the house of the complainant. The wife of the complainant Dasari Suseelamma used to pickup quarrels with accused for playing cricket near their house. On 10.4.2006, while they are playing cricket, the cricket ball lift the wife of the complainant, while she was bringing water. She pickedup a quarrel with them, abused them using filthy language and also warned them not to play cricket near her house. On that, both the accused told her as "MAA ISTAM VACHIRA CHOTA ADATRANU, MUVVEVARAVU LARMALIMI ADAVADDAMI CHEPPEDAMIKI, REHU IKKADE ADATHAMU, MER DIKKUMBA CHOTA CHEFFUKO". The same was witnessed by PWs. 3 to 6. On the sameday at about 1800 hours. widle the complainant was at his shop, both the accused pickedup a quarrel with him for informing the incident to the brother of the accused and Al kicked him with leg and A2 also beat him. Further, A2 threatened him that they would see his end, if he informs it to his brother. It was witnessed by PWs. 7 and 3. Investigation clearly disclosed that it is an offence under

sections 323,506 IPC, as no witness has stated that the accused abused the complainant or his wife, offending their caste.

The investigating of ficer of the case, approached the A.F. P. Kavali and after perusal of the case file, be opined that this is a case to be charged under sections 323 and 506 Tr.C.

The investigating officer submitted the entire case file to me with a request to accord permission to delate the provisions of SCs/STs(PCA) Act, 1989 from the case and to charge it u/s 323,506 Inc. I perused the case file and sent it to sri N. Vidyasagar, Joint Director of Prosecutions and Public Prosecutor (Retd.) Presently withing as legal Advisor, District Police Office, Nellere to seek his opinion in the matter and it is awaited.

Soon-after receipt of the opinion from the Legal Advisor, the case will be finalised on the merits and the accused will be arrested.

In view of the above facts, it is requested that the reference may please be ordered to be lodged, since the action by the Police was already initiated in the matter.
