Sir,

Kindly refer to your office letter No.KDM/Atro/Raj/692/2008/RU-I, dated
30.8.2009 and No.KDM/Atro/Harrsment/692/2008/RU-I, dated 27.8.2009, on the
subject cited above.

The complainant has alleged that her husband HC Harkesh Meena was
psychologically harassed for the last one year by the SHO due to which he has gone
into depression and lost his mental balance. She has further alleged that her husband
was detailed as MHC(M) by the SHO, although the order for posting of MHC(M) are
issued by DCP. It is further alleged that the SHO had done this because her husband
belongs to ST community.

Enquiries conducted into the matter revealed that on 6.8.08 HC Harkesh
Meena had attempted suicide by jumping from the third floor of PS Dwarka. HC
Harkesh Meena had been deputed to work as MHC(M), PS Dwarka by SHO on
19.3.2008. However, a copy of the said order was also endorsed to SIP/SWD for
issuing proper order of the competent authority. The said HC was deeply perturbed as
his casual leave application for 5+2 day was rejected on 5.8.08. Moreover, there was
heavy work load in the Malkhana and the Head Constable wanted to be transferred.

The conduct of SHO/Dwarka has been found wanting. He should have
handled a man under depression in a better manner so that such an extreme step could
have been avoided. On the request dated 28.7.08 submitted by SHO/Dwarka the HC
was transferred to Distt. Line vide order No.10206-220/SIP/SWD(D-1), dated 28.7.2008
