Please take notice that in case the Commission does not receive reply to attend the Sitting from you within the stipulated time, the Commission may exercise the powers of Civil Court conferred on it under Clause (8) of Article 338A of the Constitution of India and issue summons for the appearance in person or by a representative before the Commission. It is therefore requested you to kindly make it convenient to attend the Sitting in Commission on the Scheduled date and time with all relevant records in the case.
