Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Ananta Nayak, Hon'ble Member, NCST, in the case of Shri Basantlal Bhuia regarding the Place of Worship of the Tribals that has been illegally occupied and illegally declared as a graveyard through manipulated records in connivance with the district administration.

Date of the Sitting: 31.05.2023

Participants in the Sitting: As per Annexure

A representation was received from Shri Basantlal Bhuia, a resident of Nimiadih Village, Po Baghadu, Sonbhadra, Uttar Pradesh. It has been alleged that the tribal worship place has been illegally occupied by non-tribals over the past few years. The Deeh Baba Dham which is important as a center of traditional faith for the tribals in Nimiaheed village. It has been falsely declared as a graveyard through manipulated records with the assistance of the tehsil administration. This has resulted in the destruction of the tribe's faith and traditions. Furthermore, the tribals are being prohibited from entering their place of worship.

The Commission issued notice dated 22.03.2022 to the Chief Secretary, Govt of Uttar Pradesh, District Collector, Sonbhadra District and Superintendent of Police, Sonbhadra District to submit the Action Taken Report ("ATR") within 03 days. Pursuant thereto, the District Collector & Superintendent of Police, Sonbhadra, submitted an Action Taken Report (ATR) stating that on 13/02/23, an order was passed by the Deputy Collector, Duddi, Sonbhadra. The order stated that the disputed property has been rectified and the claimed area has been demarcated and marked with stones. The appeal against the order of the Deputy Collector, has been transferred to the Additional Judicial, Vindhyachal. Commissioner Special Subsequently, the Additional Commissioner Special Judicial, Vindhyachal, passed an order to maintain status quo in the matter and has also instructed the Duddi Police authorities to maintain law and अनंत नायकाANANTA NAYAK order.

The Commission carefully examined the petition and the replies submitted by the Authorities. Considering the sensitivity of the issue Summons dated 26.05.2023 were issued to Shri. Chandra Vijay Singh, District Collector, Sonbhadra District and Dr. Yashveer Singh, Superintendent of Police, Sonbhadra District to appear before the Commission 31.05.2023.

During the hearing on 30.05.2023, the petitioner emphasized that Deeh Baba Dham holds immense significance as a center of traditional faith for the tribals in Nimiaheed village for generations. Unfortunately, it has been illegally acquired by the Muslim community, leading to the tribals being prohibited from entering their place of worship. Furthermore, the worship place is in a dilapidated state, lacking proper maintenance and construction. It is distressing to note that neither the government nor the villagers themselves are permitted to make any alterations or improvements. In light of these circumstances, the petitioner requested for prompt action to be taken to address this issue.

Shri Chandra Vijay Singh, District Collector, Sonbhadra District and Dr. Yashveer Singh, Superintendent of Police, Sonbhadra submitted that on 13/02/23, the Deputy Collector of Sonbhadra issued an order to rectify a disputed property and demarcate the claimed area using stones. However, on appeal, the Additional Commissioner has issued an order for maintaining the status quo and instructed the Duddi Police to ensure law and order. Currently, the situation is normal, and Villagers has been granted access to worship at the place.

After hearing both the sides, the Commission recommends the following: -

- The District Collector will coordinate with the Commissioner of Vindhyachal for the speedy disposal of the case with assurance that the villagers are granted permission for worship.
- 2. The District Collector shall ensure that necessary alterations are made to the worshiping place through the district administration.
- 3. Petitioners shall co-ordinate with the District administration to maintain law and order in the area.

District Collector and Superintendent of Police, Sonbhadra will submit Action Taken Report in compliance of the Recommendations within 30 days.
