- 1. The Sitting, under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Vice Chairperson, NCST, to discuss the case of Promotion of Shri P.C. Meena, Executive Engineer, Municipal Corporation of Delhi, took place in the Conference Room of NCST on 24/12/2014 at 3:30 PM.
- 2. List of participants in the Sitting is at Annexure A.
- 3. At the outset the petitioner was asked to explain his point. The petitioner Shri P.C. Meena said that he should be given ad hoc Superintending Engineer post with effect from 28/07/2000 and also the next higher promotion as Chief Engineer. This is for the simple reason that 30 employees junior to him were promoted and are working as Chief Engineers.
- 4. Shri Lekh Raj, Office Superintendent, Central Establishment Department, North Delhi Municipal Corporation said that upon receipt of letter from NCST, MCD considered his case and ordered his promotion. He handed over a copy of Office order dated 19.12.2014, promoting notionally the petitioner Shri P.C. Meena, to the post of Superintending Engineer (Civil) with effect from 28.07.2000He explained that P.C. Meena could not be given regular promotion as the authority of regular promotion vests with UPSC. Moreover, he could not be considered for higher promotion as there is a criminal case against him.

The petitioner P.C. Meena said that

- There was no criminal case against him when his promotion became due for the post of Chief Engineer, as charges were framed only in late 2006.
- When his juniors had been given ad hoc promotion why he has been given only notional which does not entail any consequential benefits of promotion and seniority.

To this Shri Lekh Raj stated that as Shri P.C. Meena had not served in the post of Superintending Engineer he can be given only notional promotion from back date viz 28/07/2000 and cannot be considered for promotion to post of Chief Engineer.

- 5. Hearing both the parties the Hon'ble Vice Chairperson, NCST ordered that MCD should clarify the following points within 15 days.
 - a) The eligibility parameters specified in the Rules for promotion.
 - b) The periodicity of holding DPC Meeting and when it was held last
 - c) The periodicity of holding Screening Committee Meeting and when it was held last
 - d) From the year 2000 onwards, how many times promotions have been carried out/how many employees are promoted from the post of Executive Engineer to Superintending Engineer and from Superintending Engineer to Chief Engineer.
 - e) Out of this, how many are from SC, ST& OBC category.
 - f) Whether the Govt. of India Rules on Reservation in promotions are being complied with especially in respect of ST category employees.
 - g) In Superintending Engineer/Chief Engineer posts how many are earmarked for ST out of which how many are still vacant?
 - h) Screening Committee Meeting should be held immediately to consider the petitioner's case for ad hoc promotion from the due date, i.e., 28.07.2000.
 - i) List of 30 employees junior to the petitioner working as Chief Engineers to be provided.
 - MCD may also give a point wise reply to the rejoinder submitted by the petitioner in the Sitting.
- 6. The Hon'ble Vice Chairperson advised the officer, North Delhi Municipal Corporation to consider giving the petitioner his due according to his seniority and a compliance report may be submitted by 15/01/2015. Otherwise, Commission will be constrained to issue Summon to the Commissioner, MCD to appear before the Commission in the next Sitting proposed for 30/01/2015 at 1100 AM.

The Sitting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
