Minutes of the sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at New Delhi in the case of Shri B. Hari Naik, ASRM, Set-2B, RMS 'Z' Division, Kazipet RMS, Under Telangana Circle regarding settlement of pending grievances in declaration of PS Group B LDCE result.

Shri B. Hari Naik, Assistant Superintendent RMS (ASRM), RMS 'Z' Division, Kazipet, vide his representation dated 18.11.2025 has stated that his result of PS Group 'B' LDCE-2020, declared provisionally on 01.06.2022, was kept in sealed cover due to the major penalty of reduction of pay for a specified period of five years from 01.04.2019 to 31.03.2024, which has since expired. He has submitted that no disciplinary or criminal case was pending against him either on the date of notification or on the date of declaration of results, and that as per DoPT O.M. dated 15.12.2004, DoPT letter dated 28.04.2014, and Department of Posts letters dated 17.05.2023 and 22.09.2023, his result ought to be opened and promotion given effect after expiry of the penalty period. The petitioner has further stated that despite making repeated representations dated 20.05.2024, 30.07.2025, 14.10.2025 and 20.10.2025, the Postal Directorate (DE Section), Dak Bhawan, New Delhi has not declared his sealed cover result, even though he was promoted as Assistant Superintendent of Posts vide order dated 15.07.2024 after expiry of the punishment. He has therefore requested the Commission to take up the matter with the Director General (Posts) for early opening of the sealed cover and declaration of his PS Group 'B' LDCE-2020 result with effect from 01.04.2024 in accordance with the prescribed rules.

2. NCST issued notice to the Director General, Department of Posts vide NCST letter dated 20.11.2025 for seeking facts and comments within 15 days from receipt of the Notice.

3. D/o Posts vide letter no. DE-16/1/2025-DE-DOP dated 12.12.2025 has informed that the grievance of Shri B. Hari Naik, applicant for PS Group 'B' LDCE-2020 held on 29.11.2020, relates to declaration of his result kept in sealed cover due to the currency of a disciplinary penalty and pendency of litigation. It has been stated that the petitioner was initially imposed with a penalty of compulsory retirement on 30.10.2017, which was later modified by the Appellate Authority to reduction of pay by three stages for five years vide order dated 26.03.2019, and the said penalty remained in currency up to 31.03.2024. The petitioner was allowed to appear in the LDCE pursuant to an interim order dated 20.12.2019 of the Hon'ble CAT, Hyderabad Bench in O.A. No. 1098/2019, subject to the final outcome of the case, and therefore his result was kept in sealed cover as on the date of declaration of results on 01.06.2022. The Hon'ble CAT, vide its final order dated 18.09.2024, dismissed the OA and vacated the interim relief, thereby restricting the petitioner's eligibility only to the vacancy year 2020. After the CAT judgment, the case was examined at Directorate level and it was observed that the petitioner did not fall under the conditions of suspension, charge-sheet or criminal proceedings on the crucial dates; accordingly, the Telangana Circle was repeatedly requested vide letters dated 19.11.2024, 25.04.2025 and 06.08.2025 to re-examine the matter and furnish revised vigilance status and recommendations. It has been further informed that the revised response from the Telangana Circle is still awaited despite a reminder email dated 09.12.2025, and that the matter is presently under examination, after which appropriate action will be taken strictly in accordance with the applicable rules governing sealed cover procedure and LDCE result declaration.

4. The reply was not satisfactory, hence, it was decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 06.01.2026. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 26.12.2025. The Director, D/o Posts vide letter dated 31.12.2025 has requested for exemption and deputed DDG (Establishment) and Liaison Officer to attend the sitting.

5. In the sitting, the above officers of D/o Posts and petitioner were present. The petitioner has reiterated his earlier submissions and requested for justice. The officers from D/o Posts informed that the matter has been resolved.




6. After discussion with the officers of D/o Posts and petitioner, it was observed that the matter has been resolved, hence, no action warranted on part of NCST.
