Minutes of the sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at New Delhi in the case of Shri Kurra Sarakka, 16-1- E Kataram Road Manthani, Peddapalli, Telangana State regarding atrocities committed on her and family members in unauthorized demolitisation of her house by the District Administration.

Smt. Kurra Sarakka, wife of Shri Kurra Lingaiah, belonging to ST (Yerukala) community, vide her representation dated 31.10.2025 has alleged that despite having valid permissions and NOC granted by the Municipal and Revenue Authorities for construction of a G+1 house in Survey No. 314, Manthani Municipal limits, and despite an interim stay and subsequent stay order dated 30.10.2025 and 27.11.2025 respectively passed by the Hon'ble High Court in Writ Petition No. 15306/2025, the District Collector, Peddapalli, RDO, Municipal Commissioner, Town Planning Officer, Tahsildar, and Manthani Police officials forcibly demolished her house at around 5.00 AM on 31.10.2025. She has further stated that she and her family members were allegedly taken to the police station, their mobile phones were seized, and the demolition rendered them homeless, causing severe financial loss of about Rs. 1.35 crore and mental trauma. The petitioner has alleged willful disobedience of the Hon'ble High Court's orders and discrimination due to her Scheduled Tribe status, and has prayed for compensation, inquiry against the concerned officials, and justice for the harm caused to her family.

2. NCST issued notice to the Collector & District Magistrate, District- Peddapalli and Commissioner of Police, District-Peddapalli on 20.11.2025 for seeking facts and comments within 15 days from receipt of Notice. The reply was not received, hence, NCST has decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 07.01.2026. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 26.12.2025. There was no response received from District Collector, Peddapalli.

3. In the sitting, DCP, District-Peddapalli was present and petitioner joined via phone. The petitioner has reiterated her earlier submission and requested for justice. The DCP, District-Peddapalli has provided their letter bearing no. O3/NCST/DCP-P/2025 dated 24.12.2025 which contains the facts and comments and stated that there is no role of Police Department. In the letter, it has been informed that the petitioner has filed a WP. No. 15306 of 2025 before the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana in the matter. Hon'ble High Court in its order dated 30.10.2025 has issued a stay order till 27.11.2025. Meanwhile, Municipal Commissioner and Tehsildar has demolished the House on 31.10.2025. Further, it is also informed that the case was posted on 29.12.2025 and 27.1.2026.


4. On the basis of papers submitted by the DCP, District-Peddapalli and discussion held with them, it was observed that the Tehsildar and officers of Municipal Corporation has violated the orders of Hon'ble High Court.

5. After discussion with the concerned authority and petitioner, it was observed that no action warranted on part of NCST, as the matter is subjudice before the Hon'ble High Court. However, the District Collector & Magistrate, Peddapalli and Municipal Commissioner, Manthani is advised to enquire into the matter and initiate action for compensation to the victim for demolition of her house besides disciplinary action against the erring officials(MRO and Municipal Commissioner).
