NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR SCHEDULED TRIBES

Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Dilkusha Guest House, Hyderabad in the case of Smt. Gugulothu Nagamani regarding financial fraud committed against her.

Smt. Gugulothu Nagamani, resident of Thoorpu Thanda village, Dantalapalli Mandal, Mahabubabad District, Telangana, and proprietor of Kanakadurga Agro Tech Para-Boiled Unit, has represented that Sri Vanamala Nageswara Rao has committed large-scale financial fraud by forging her signature and issuing cheques worth Rs. 11.76 crores to the CMR (Civil Supplies Department), Mahabubabad GM, in her name. He also forged her signature on blank cheques and filed a fraudulent application to S.F.A.C., New Delhi, besides misusing cheques to withdraw Rs. 40 lakhs taken as a CC loan for her mill. A police case (Crime No. 74/2025 dated 07.06.2025) was registered, but no action has been taken. She has further stated that the accused illegally sold a 2-ton machine from her old mill on 13.03.2024, and despite complaints to the Dantalapalli Police Station, no response has been received. She has therefore requested the intervention of the Commission for investigation and justice in the matter.

2. The Commission issued notice to the Superintendent of Police, District-Mahabubabad vide NCST letter dated 02.09.2025 seeking facts and comments within 15 days.

3. Reply was not received, hence, the Commission decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 27.10.2025. But the sitting was postponed and refixed on 28.1.2026. Accordingly, a sitting notice was sent on 23.1.2026.

4. The petitioner attended the hearing. The authority was represented by the SDPO, Mahabubabad District.

5. The petitioner has reiterated her plea that she is the proprietor of Kanakadurga Agro Tech Para-Boiled Unit, has represented that Sri Vanamala Nageswara Rao has committed large-scale financial fraud by forging her signature and issuing cheques worth Rs. 11.76 crores to the CMR (Civil Supplies Department), Mahabubabad GM, in her name. He also forged her signature on blank cheques and filed a fraudulent application to S.F.A.C., New Delhi, besides misusing cheques to withdraw Rs. 40 lakhs taken as a CC loan for her mill. She has further stated that the current bill, EMI and GST are being borne by her since last 2 years which is causing a huge loss for her. She has further stated that the accused illegally sold a 2-ton machine from her old mill on 13.03.2024, and despite complaints to the Dantalapalli Police Station, no response has been received.

6. The authority has informed that the mill is leased out for 20 years as per the agreement and it will become a civil dispute if intervened.

After hearing to the petitioner and authority the following recommendations are made and the ATR may be submitted in 30 days from the receipt of the minutes.

- a. The alleged forged documents may be sent to the Forensic science lab for the examination and findings.
- b. The FIR registered shall be concluded towards logical end and necessary action may be taken on the culprits involved in the theft of the machinery.
- c. Custom Mill Rice(CMR) agreement may be cancelled as the mill is not working.
- d. The police may take necessary action on the alleged individual and ensure that the pending dues are paid to the petitioner.
- e. The FCI may submit a report and attend to the next scheduled date of meeting.
