Shri V. Jayaramudu Naik @ Vijay Naik, resident of Nandyal District and presently at Kurnool, has filed a complaint alleging that on 24.06.2025 he was forcibly taken by police personnel of III Town Police Station, Kurnool, illegally detained at District Police Training Centre Barrack No. 13, and subjected to third-degree custodial torture with caste-based abuses and threats of encounter, in retaliation for his pending SC.SPL. No. 87/2024 against Sub-Inspector Srikanth Reddy and civil suit O.S. No. 267/2021 for malicious prosecution. He further alleges that a false FIR in Cr. No. 210/2025 was registered against him under BNS and IT Act provisions, that he was remanded on 25.06.2025, and that a rowdy sheet No. 355 dated 16.07.2025 was opened vindictively after his release. The petitioner also alleges illegal detention and custodial torture of other persons, including the death of Shanti Pawan Kumar on 05.07.2025, destruction/refusal of CCTV footage sought through RTI dated 16.09.2025, and continued threats by the concerned police officials. He seeks independent inquiry, criminal and departmental action against the named officers, quashing of the FIR and rowdy sheet, preservation of records, protection from harassment, and compensation of Rs. 10,00,000/- for custodial torture and caste-based humiliation.

2. NCST vide notice dated 19.12.2025 sought facts and comments from the Superintendent of Police, District- Kurnool within 30 days from receipt of the notice. The reply was not received, hence, NCST decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 17.02.2026. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 06.02.2026.

3. In the sitting, the SDPO, Kurnool was present on behalf of Supdt. of Police, Kurnool. The petitioner was not present and also no communication received from him. The SDPO, Kurnool has provided the letter bearing no. 16103/C4/NCST/DCRB/KNL/2026 dated 3.2.2026, which contains the facts and comments on the issue raised in the petition dated 24.6.2025 of the petitioner. In the letter, it has been informed that the allegations made by the petitioner are baseless, as he wants to obstruct the trial process before the Hon'ble Courts by the threatening the police officials and other witnesses.


4. After discussion with above officer and facts submitted by SP, Kurnool vide letter dated 3.2.2026, it was observed that no action warranted on part of NCST, as the matter is pending with the Hon'ble Courts.
