

NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR SCHEDULED TRIBES

Minutes of the sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at New Delhi in the case of Shri Bukke Raja Naik, a Scheduled Tribe resident of Chinnakampalli, Kadapa, Chintakomma Dinne Mandal, Cuddapah District of Andhra Pradesh on Illegal encroachment of his ST-assigned land since 2019; request for restoration and protection.

Shri Bukke Raja Naik, resident of Chinnakampalli Village, Kadapa District, has represented that agricultural land admeasuring Ac.2.64 cents in Survey No.1612 was assigned in favour of his mother Late Smt. B. Devi and his wife Smt. B. Muthyalamma vide DKT Nos.1/1403 and 2/1403 dated 29.11.1993, and the family has been in peaceful possession since then. He has alleged that from 2019 onwards, influential persons have illegally encroached upon the assigned land and prevented them from cultivation, and despite repeated representations to the District Collector, YSR Kadapa District, including through the Spandana grievance system, no effective action has been taken. He further stated that he was orally informed about cancellation of the assignment, but no written cancellation order was served, and the land was not resumed by the Government. He has sought intervention of the Commission for enquiry into the encroachment, restoration of possession of the assigned land, and action against officials for failure to protect ST assigned land.

2. NCST vide notice dated 22.12.2025 sought facts and comments from the District Collector & Magistrate, District:- YSR Kadapa within 30 days from receipt of the Notice. The reply was not received, hence, NCST has decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 17.02.2026. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 06.02.2026.

3. The District Collector vide later dated 14.2.26 has stated that the matter is currently sub-judice before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh in W.P No. 13968 of 2025 and WA No. 684 of 2025 where in the status quo has been directed and the same has been strictly complied with. In the sitting, the RDO & SDM, YSR Kadapa was present on behalf of District Collector & Magistrate, District – YSR Kadapa. The petitioner was also present. The petitioner has reiterated his earlier submission and requested for justice.

4. After discussion with the above officer and petitioner, the following observations/ecommendations were made and action taken there on may be submitted to NCST within 30 days from receipt of the minutes.

a. The status represents the lack of coordination between the Revenue and Forests Departments.



b. It may be clarified how assigned land is cancelled without intimating the assignees through proper notices and serving the cancellation orders. The evidences if any of such cancellation order and notices may be submitted to NCST.

c. The District Collector, DFO and AD Survey and settlements may attend for the next scheduled date of hearing with a detailed report.
