Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Lok Nayak Bhawan, New Delhi in the case of Shri K. Seetharam Naik, SBMS, Devasthanam, Srisailam regarding allotment of shops in Sri Lalitambica Shopping Complex.

Shri K. Seetharam Naik, SBMS, Devasthanam, Srisailam, vide his petition dated 25.01.2025 has stated that nearly 30 families belonging to the ST Banjara Community have been residing in Srisailam Devasthanam Township for the past 40 years and are facing severe livelihood challenges due to their dependence on the collection and sale of wild products and labour work. To improve their economic conditions, they have been requesting the allotment of at least 10 shops in Sri Lalitambica Shopping Complex, similar to the 30 shops allotted to the ST Chenchus at a rate of Rs. 3,000/- per month. Despite multiple references from various departments, no action has been taken. The petitioner urges the Commission to intervene and issue necessary directions to the Executive Officer, SBMS Devastanam, Srisailam, for the allotment of shops on humanitarian grounds.

- 2. NCST vide notice dated 06.02.2025 has referred the matter to the Executive Officer, Srisailam Devasthanam for facts and comments within 30 days from receipt of the Notice. The reply was not received, hence, Commission decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 27.03.2025. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 13.03.2025.
- 3. The EO, Srisailam Devasthanam vide letter dated 21.3.2025 has sought exemption and deputed Asstt. Commissioner of Srisailam Devasthanam to attend the sitting.
- 4. In the sitting, the Asstt. Commissioner of Srisailam Devasthanam was present. It was informed that due to a court judgement in 2021 the shops were auctioned. The petitioners have informed that they were requesting since 2011.
- 5. After discussion with the Asstt. Commissioner of Srisailam Devasthanam, the following recommendations were made and action taken thereon may be submitted to NCST within 30 days from receipt of the minutes.

a. The petitioners may be allocated shops at other place if it is not possible to allocate at SBMS Devasthanam due to Court judgement.

b. The E.O Srisailam may consider the request of the petitioners solely dependent on salke of Forest products and mionor handicrafts and take necessary action of identification of suitable place for allotment of shops for the livelihood of ST Banjaras.
