Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Lok Nayak Bhawan, New Delhi in the case of Smt D. Jyothi regarding employment with humanitarian care.

**Date of the Sitting: 10/02/2025, 2:00 PM**  
**Participants in the Sitting: As per Annexure**

Smt. Daravath Jyothi, alleged that she was denied the contract/outsourcing job despite having prior experience working in the PHC. She further claimed that the part-time, daily wage posts in the Tribal Welfare Hostels are filled through bribes involving lakhs of rupees, without any open notifications. She requested a detailed enquiry and sought justice.

2. NCST vide notice dated 11.12.2024 had referred the matter to the Commissioner of Tribal Welfare Department, Govt. of Telangana, Hyderabad, The Collector & District Magistrate, Suryapet (Telangana) and the District Medical & Health Officer, Suryapet District for seeking facts and comments within 30 days. The reply was not received from the concerned authorities. Hence, NCST decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 10.02.2025. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 31.01.2025.

3. The Collector & District Magistrate, Suryapet (Telangana) vide letter dated 6.2.2025 has sought exemption due to Model Code of Conduct is in force and state that the detailed report will be sent shortly. The Commissioner, Tribal Welfare Department, Govt. of Telangana and petitioner were present in the sitting.


4. In the sitting the petitioner has submitted its earlier submission and requested for justice. The Commissioner, Tribal Welfare Department, Govt. of Telangana, supported the facts submitted by District Collector vide letter dated 6.2.2025.

5. The petitioner has informed that though the eligible candidates who are having the prior experience are available the candidates are being hired from the neighboring districts by illegal means and Smt. Dharavath Jyothi is denied for contract/outsourcing posts as second ANM though the vacancies are there and she is having the experience of working in PHC during covid time.

6. The authority has informed that the District Collector has submitted the report and has informed that the issue will be examined after the Model code of Conduct for the ensuing MLC elections in the District. It is further informed that the finance clearance is mandatory to engage any staff on contract or outsourcing basis.

7. After the discussion with officers of Govt. of Telangana and petitioner, the following was recommended and action taken report thereon may be submitted within 30 days from the receipt of the minutes.


- A detailed enquiry may be conducted on the DTDO Suryapet on alleged complaint of the petitioner.
- The outsourcing agency of TTWREIS and Tribal welfare may be pursued to consider Smt Dharavath Jyothi on out sourcing basis in the existing vacancy in Suryapet District on humanitarian grounds.
- The detailed report in the case may be furnished by the Collector & District Magistrate.
